CHILD FIND

Child Find is a foundational component of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), which requires every state to identify, locate, and evaluate all children with disabilities, from birth to their 22nd birthday, who may need special education and related services. Parents and community members within the SLO SELPA boundaries who suspect a child has special needs are encouraged to contact their local school district.

- Send Child Find notices to community agencies
- Provide information to area pediatricians
- Send annual information to private schools
